



ABOUT THE ADDITIONAL SUPPORT GRANT FOR LOW-INCOME HOUSEHOLDS 2024

PURPOSE OF THE GRANT

- To reduce the burden caused by the rising prices of energy, food, and other goods, we will provide a grant of 30,000 yen per household to low-income households (households exempt from residence tax in 2024).

ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS

(A) Households where all members are exempt from residence tax for the year 2024 as of December 13, 2024.

※ Households consisting only of dependents of those who are subject to residence tax will not be eligible for this grant.

※ Households consisting only of people who do not live in Japan as of January 1, 2024, will not be eligible for this grant.

GRANT AMOUNT: 30,000 yen per household

(Note) Each household can only receive the grant once.

Households that are registered as residents in Sue Town as of December 13, 2024, and where all members are exempt from residence tax for the year 2024 will be eligible.

1. Fill out the necessary information and submit the form

Eligible individuals will receive a grant notice, a confirmation letter, or an application form from the Sue Town Office.

GRANT NOTICE:

Check the contents, and if there are no changes, no reply is necessary. If there are changes, please contact us.

CONFIRMATION LETTER:

Check the contents, fill out the necessary information, and return it using the enclosed reply envelope.

APPLICATION FORM:

If someone in the household has not filed their residence tax, please submit the tax declaration. If they are exempt from residence tax, they will be eligible for the grant.

(Note) The deadline for submission is June 30, 2025.

2. After checking the submitted information, we will transfer the grant

IF YOU RECEIVE THE GRANT NOTICE:

The grant will be transferred on March 28, 2025 (Friday).

IF YOU RECEIVE THE CONFIRMATION LETTER OR APPLICATION FORM:

The grant will be transferred to the account provided within 30 days from the day Sue Town receives the form.
